- 6. What is saddest in this story: Azucena's suffering or the fact that no one cares? Should the public be allowed to watch personal suffering such as Azucena's? Explain your thinking.
- 7. How is Rolf changed as a result of knowing Azucena?
- 8. Why may Allende have chosen to use Rolf's wife as the narrator for this story?
- 9. Note the frequent references to cameras, lenses, and screens in this story. How is this imagery related to the meaning of this story?
- 10. Note the references to clay and mud. How is this imagery related to the meaning of the story?
