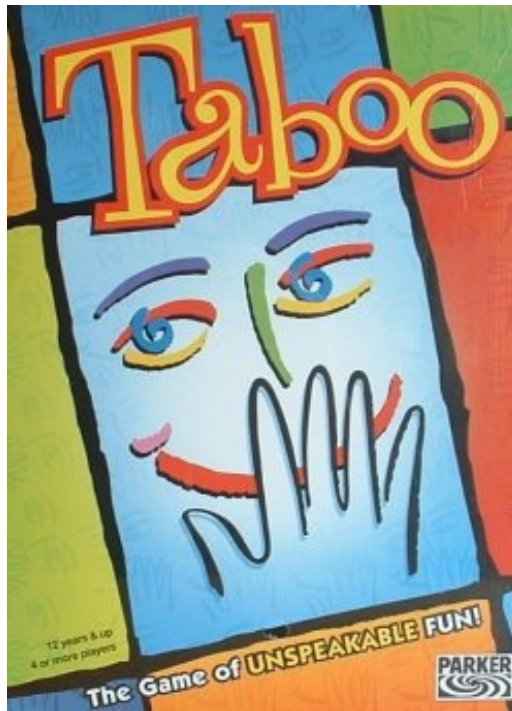


# Taboo Review



# Guidelines

- To review this time, we are going to play Taboo. Who can explain the rules?
- Step One:
  - Create five cards using the index cards provided. Write the word that the player will guess on the top of the card. Write three words the other player may not use to help her teammate guess on the bottom of the card (same side).
- Step Two:
  - When everyone has finished creating cards, I will play a song. What do you want to hear?
  - As the song plays, carry your cards with you and walk (or skip, or dance - just don't get hurt) around the room. When I stop the music, high five the person closest to you. She is your partner.

# Guidelines

- Step Three
  - When I say “go,” you will have one minute to try and get your partner to guess as many of the words you’ve chosen as possible. Remember not to use the words at the bottom of the cards!
- Step Four
  - Switch roles. For the next minute of play, your partner will try to get you to guess their words.
- Step Five
  - Do we want a different song for round two? When the music starts again, thank your partner for playing and walk (skip, dance...) as you prepare to play again.
